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## BRIEF GUIDE TO FIND YOUR LEVEL

This guide does not contain all the areas that will be covered in your class. Classes are very interactive, and fun. Students learn by practicing full patterns in a variety of scenarios. Although grammar is not the focus, it is embedded within the oral exercises and homework. Level 1 and 2 are conducted MOSTLY in Spanish. After level 3, all levels are conducted ONLY in Spanish.

LEVEL 1	You want to speak Spanish from day 1! You will learn to introduce yourself, ask and answer basic questions, use everyday expressions, apply hundreds of cognates (Latin origin words used in both languages) and order food!
LEVEL 2	You understand the basic structure of Spanish and can identify between masculine and feminine, singular, and plural. You also know basic vocabulary, such as days of the week, months, colors, seasons of the year, some numbers, etc.).
LEVEL 3	You know the structure of the language and have good vocabulary lists under your belt. You need to be introduced to all the uses of SER and ESTAR, and their expressions, as well as regular verbs in the present tense.
LEVEL 4	You have knowledge of the uses of SER & ESTAR in the present tense, as well as regular verbs. You would like to increase your repertoire and include irregular verbs.
LEVEL 5	You have been exposed to conjugation of regular and irregular verbs in the present tense and would like to begin using direct and indirect object pronouns for a more fluid conversation.
LEVEL 6	You have the regular and irregular present tense verbs under control and now it is time to be introduced to future tenses, as well as reflexive verbs.
LEVEL 7	You have already studied present and future tenses. You also have experience using object pronouns and reflexive verbs. Now, it is time for you to tackle a past tense: the preterit.
LEVEL 8	You have studied the preterit tense, as well as other tenses. Now, the imperfect tense comes to the picture. Once introduced, you will have the opportunity to practice and expand your skills using preterit and imperfect tenses.
LEVEL 9	You already can speak Spanish with some fluidity. It is time for you to tackle the subjunctive mode so you can express your wishes and opinions about complex topics with more ease.
LEVEL 10	You already speak the language with fluidity. You have studied and practiced all tenses, including subjunctive. You want to participate in a class where you can converse about interesting topics, but still want to receive input, correction, and/or suggestions.
